Kanbar Cardiac Center

The Kanbar Center offers advanced technology and state-of-the-art equipment to diagnose heart disease, treat people with irregular heartbeats, and open blocked vessels or arteries. Our nationally-recognized physicians and surgeons are committed to providing excellent personalized care in contemporary facilities. Outpatient diagnostic non-invasive services include:

- ECG
- Echocardiography
- Holter Monitors – 24 to 48 hour heart rhythm monitoring
- Two cardiac catheterization laboratories for treating patients with blocked vessels or arteries, and helping to diagnose the causes of heart failure
- Event Monitors – record specific events of rhythm abnormalities
- Stress Testing – records real-time EKG during exercise and pharmacologic stress testing

- Cardiac ultrasound for pediatric and adult patients
- Electrophysiology Laboratory – for treating patients with irregular heartbeats through Cardiac Resynchronization Therapy and Implantable Cardiac Defibrillators

Cardiovascular Surgery

California Pacific's cardiovascular and thoracic surgical team utilizes leading edge technology, combined with research and, comprehensive and compassionate patient care. Offering breakthrough surgical therapy for heart and lung patients, our surgeons are committed to providing excellent treatment for the simplest conditions to the most complex. Patients also benefit from the newest technology available with clinical research trials that provide opportunities to access the latest therapies.

Heart Failure, Artificial Heart and Heart Transplant

California Pacific Medical Center initiated the nation's first heart transplant service outside a university hospital in 1984 and has been at the forefront of disease management and transplant ever since. We were the first center in the nation to successfully place and maintain a patient on a bi-ventricular assist device while waiting for a donor heart and have been a leader in developing the "bridge-to-transplantation."

California Pacific's Heart Failure, LVAD and Heart Transplant program emphasizes going beyond medicine for end-stage cardiac disease management. This creates a unique program with excellent outcomes and personal attention.

Cardiac Rehabilitation

Promoting wellness through lifestyle changes, the Cardiac Rehabilitation program offers individualized treatment plans in a safe medical environment. Services include exercise, education and stress management. Directed by your physician, the Cardiac Rehabilitation team includes registered nurses, exercise physiologists and dietitians.

Cardiac Services Recent Awards & Recognition

- The Society of Chest Pain Centers (SCPC) has awarded California Pacific Medical Center Chest Pain Center accreditation, one of only five accredited Chest Pain Centers in California. This accreditation is given only to facilities that have demonstrated their commitment and expertise in providing patients with consistent quality in the prompt delivery of emergency cardiac care based on national guidelines established by leaders in cardiovascular and emergency medicine.
- In July 2007, we will be one of only three West Coast hospitals to have a Stereotaxis lab. Compared to traditional interventional cardiac procedures in which doctors manually navigate instruments, such as catheters and guide wires, the Stereotaxis magnetic navigation system is computer-controlled and uses magnets to direct instruments through blood vessels in to the heart. Doctors digitally control movement of the instruments from a control room outside the operating suite using monitors and point-and-click navigation tools and other instruments.
- West Coast Clinical Excellence Award from the VHA for new cardiac surgery practice guidelines that result in fewer complications.
- West Coast Performance Improvement Recognition Award from the VHA and the Alpha Phi Foundation Excellence in Cardiac Care Award for Transitional Cardiac Care.
